

Master logo artwork and templates have been created for each accredited logo suite. The relationship between the symbol and text is fixed and **should not be altered in any way**. Master artworks are supplied on the the portal. Permission to use the logos must be sought first.

The following specifications govern the use of the ECDL Foundation/National Operator Accredited Test Centre and Accredited Tester logos. The relationship between the elements is fixed and should not be altered in any way. Master artwork for the logo mark can be downloaded and is available on the portal. **Note:** These logos can only be used once the courseware, test provider or test centre has been approved by ECDL Foundation or a National Operator. The full colour version of the logo is the preferred option.

Clear Zone

The clear zone is the area surrounding the logo mark that must be kept free of other graphic elements. The minimum clear zone is defined by half the diameter of the globe symbol.



Minimum Size

To ensure the logo mark is clearly reproduced a minimum size has been specified. The minimum size is 8mm in height.
